WHAT IT IS?



*A disease caused

animal urine*

WHEN RISK IS HIGHER



*Risk increases
during rainy
season, floods, or
when
working in wet
environments*

HOW IT SPREADS



*Bacteria enter
through cuts in skin,
eyes, or mouth when
in contact with
water, soil, or food
contaminated by
infected animal
urine
(especially rats)*

WHAT IT FEELS LIKE



*Fever, chills,
strong headache,
muscle aches, red
eyes,
stomach pain,
vomiting*
